PRE-K INFORMATION PACKET

All correspondence in Pre-k will be by email. If at any time you would like a hard copy of any information please let us know and we will be happy to make a copy for you.

CUBBIES: Please make sure your child has a COMPLETE change of clothes (shirt, pants/shorts, underwear and socks) in his /her cubby. Anyone can have an accident, we have juice and milk spills every day. The children feel better in their own clothes. Please check cubbies every day for artwork. Remember tennis shoes are best for climbing, running and playing outside. During the fall and winter please remember to send mittens and a hat every day. We try to go outside if only for a few minutes and it is necessary that the children have their hat and mittens.

BIRTHDAY TREATS: Your child is welcome to bring treats in to celebrate his/her special day. All treats brought to school must be store bought (this is required by the health department) If you send in treats there are 24 students and 3 teachers every day. Please make sure there are **no peanuts** of any kind in your treats. Also, please make sure you notify one of the teachers a few days prior to the day so we can notify the kitchen.

BUZZ BOOK: This is a class phone book. It comes in handy for play dates and birthday invitations. If you would like to be included please email back the attached information **by September 2, 2011** to Miss Leanne. This will be composed and sent out as a document this year, not sent home in hard copy.

CALENDAR: A calendar will be e-mailed to you at the beginning of every month. It will contain the themes and letters for the month and any other information regarding our classroom.

TOTE BAGS: Please have your child bring their tote bag to school every day. It is important for the children to get in the habit of bringing it back and forth to school. This will serve many purposes. It will provide a way to get their school papers and art project home as well as build a routine before it is required in kindergarten.

CLASS PARTIES: The children help plan the games and refreshments for the parties. There are 24 children in our class. Your child will be assigned one party for which he/she will be responsible for providing an assigned item. You will be notified via email prior to the party and asked to provide a specific item. CLUBS: Each month we will focus on one club. The clubs will help prepare your child for success in kindergarten. Please help your child at home to help him/her accomplish these tasks. There will be a reminder on the monthly calendar as to what is required. The children LOVE making it into the club!

September- I know the months of the year! (In order)

October- I know my birthday! (Date and Year)

November- I know my address! (street address, city and zip)

December- I know my phone number! (area code and #. The # you want them to know by heart, cell or home)

January- I can button, snap and zip!

February- I can print my name! (on a sentence strip first letter capital, rest lower case)

March- I know my left and right!

April- I can tie my shoe!

May - I can take care of myself! (They should be responsible for taking artwork home, giving to parents and bringing back empty tote bag)

Field Trips: We do take field trips occasionally. We are always looking for help on field trip days. If you are interested in helping there will be a sign up sheet on the main floor door prior to the event.

SHOW –N-TELL: WE will begin show and tell **on August 15, 2011**. Your child may bring a show -n- tell that pertains to the theme or letter of the week. Your child may only bring her /his show -n- tell in on their assigned day of the week according to the team chart below. This a learning experience, not “what can I bring.” Show and tell will end March 16, 2012.

STUDENT OF THE WEEK: Each week we will have a Student of the Week. Being student of the Week is a special way for the children to share information about themselves and their families with the other students. We will send you an e mail as a reminder prior to his/her assigned week. All the great items your child brings needs to fit on the bulletin board above the cubbies. Some information you might want to include: is your child’s favorite food, color, hobby or favorite book. Your child’s birthday, his/her family members, friend, pets or something special about your child. It is always great to include pictures and other small items that are special for your child. A list is included at the end of this packet so you can mark your calendar!

TEAMS: Each child is assigned to a team. Teams are for job purposes as well as aiding in work completion. The color of the team determines which day they are to bring show and tell. The color of their cubby box is the color team they are on.
